

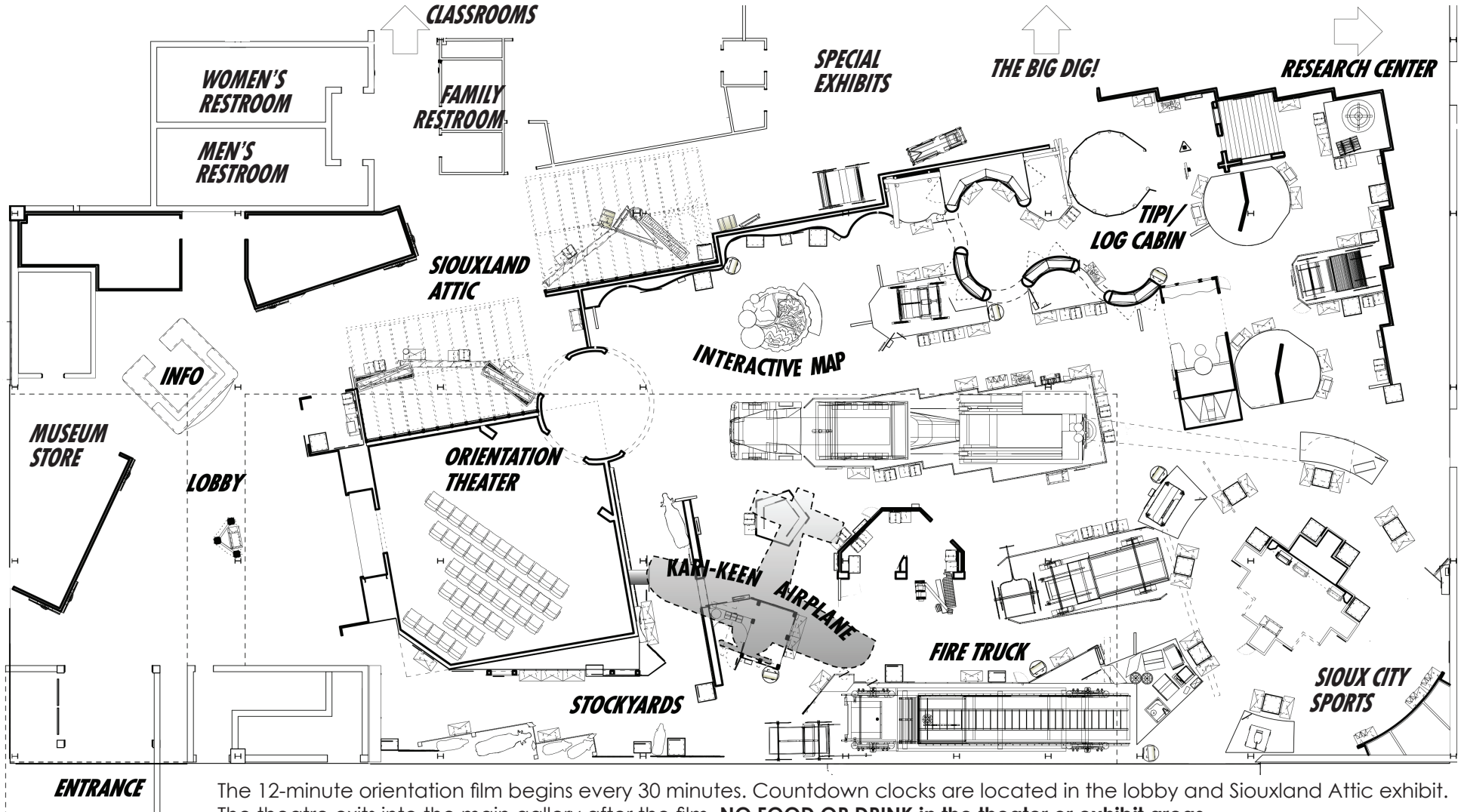


**SIoux CITY PUBLIC MUSEUM**

The 12-minute orientation film begins every 30 minutes. Countdown clocks are located in the lobby and Siouxland Attic exhibit. The theatre exits into the main gallery after the film. **NO FOOD OR DRINK in the theater or exhibit areas.**

Every 10 minutes siren lights and an announcement signal the beginning of one of three Sioux City disaster presentations next to the fire truck.
